Math Requirements by Major

The core curriculum requires all students to take at least one college level math course, MAT 106 or higher. MAT 098 and 102 will not fulfill this requirement. Any other math course numbered 106 or higher will satisfy the requirement; however, the specific course(s) that you will need to take will be determined by your major. Some majors require more than one math course. The course you need to take first will be determined by your placement scores. You will meet with your advisor to determine which course you should take first. See the table of math requirements by major below.

In the table below, the courses listed under "Math Requirements" are the minimum courses that must be taken to fulfill the math requirements for the major and the core curriculum. Higher numbered courses may be used to fulfill the requirement. Some majors may require further math courses besides those listed. "Prerequisites" are courses that must be taken before taking the required course(s) if the student does not place into the required course.

Note that MAT 098 is developmental, so the credits for this course do not count towards graduation. The credits for MAT 102 do count towards graduation; however, both MAT 098 and 102 serve only as prerequisites for other courses and **cannot be used to fulfill the math requirement for the Core Curriculum**.
