- A 500-Word Essay describing past academic/career achievements, future career goals, and interest in the Finance and/or Human Resources Management major
- Letter of Professional Recommendation from three professional and/or academic sources. (Please refer to the Professional Recommendation Form in the application packet.)
- An Official Academic Transcript for the Undergraduate and/or Graduate degree(s) (Lincoln University Alumni with an earned degree are exempt.)
- Optional Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and/or Miller Analogies Test (MAT)
