Job Summary:

We seek an individual with digital skills who can develop and teach undergraduate courses in storytelling across print, radio, broadcast, video and online platforms, as well as television and digital media production. Preference will be given to candidates who can teach other general courses in mass media studies. Tenure track faculty members must establish a record of effective teaching, service and either scholarly research or creative activity.

Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in Mass Communications, Communication Studies, Media Studies or closely related field required.
- Ph.D. or ABD preferred.
- Terminal degree must be completed for tenure consideration.
- Preference will be given to candidates who possess industry experience in any or all of the following:
 - (1) Broadcasting
 - (2) Web design and/or digital media production
- Candidates should provide evidence of teaching effectiveness.
- The University is committed to fostering a global perspective. The successful candidate will have demonstrated ability to teach and work with persons from diverse backgrounds.

Working conditions:

Work is primarily performed in a university campus environment and requires a flexible schedule including evening and weekend work. The employee is subject to inside environmental conditions: protection from weather conditions but not necessarily from temperature changes.
