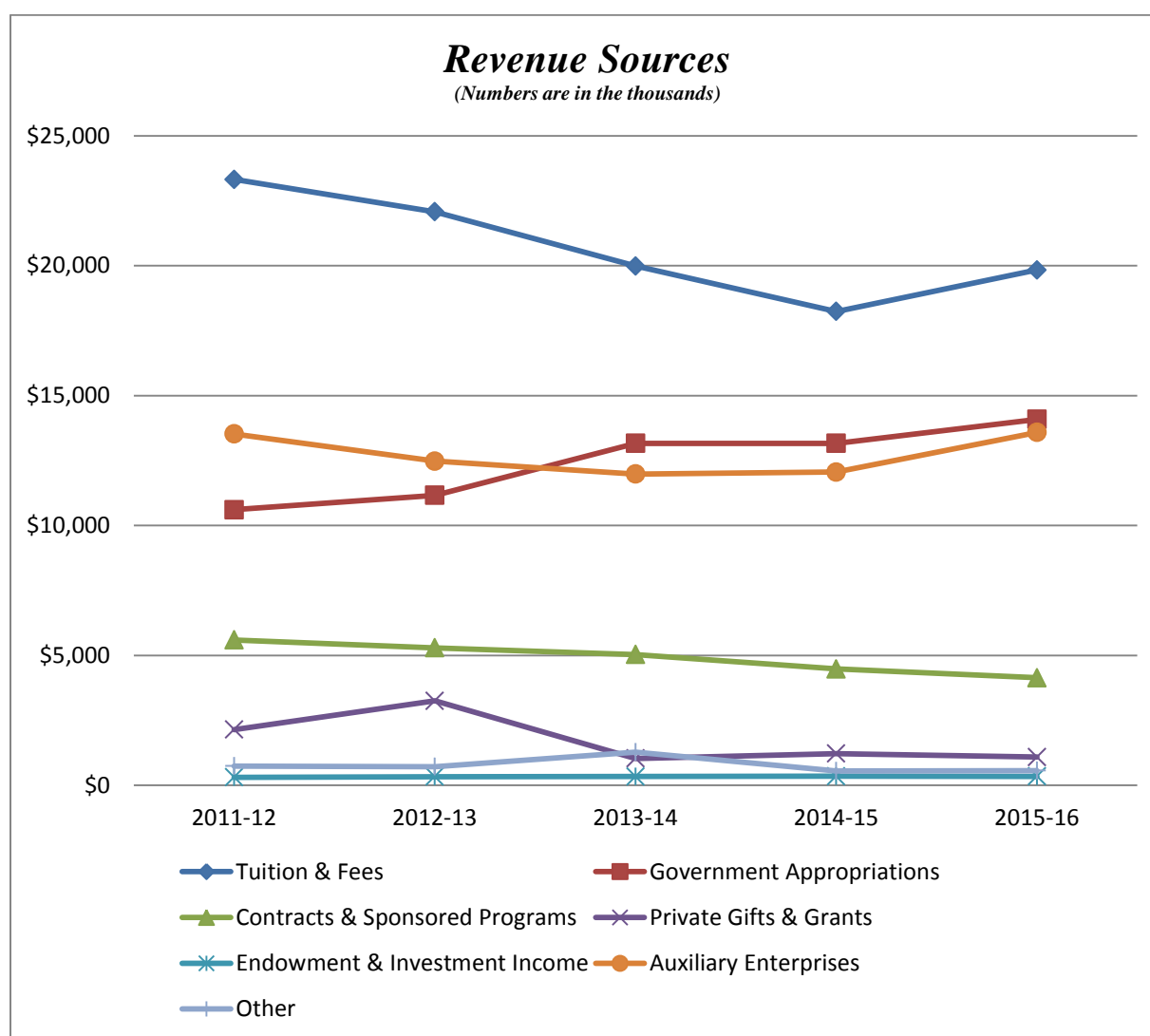

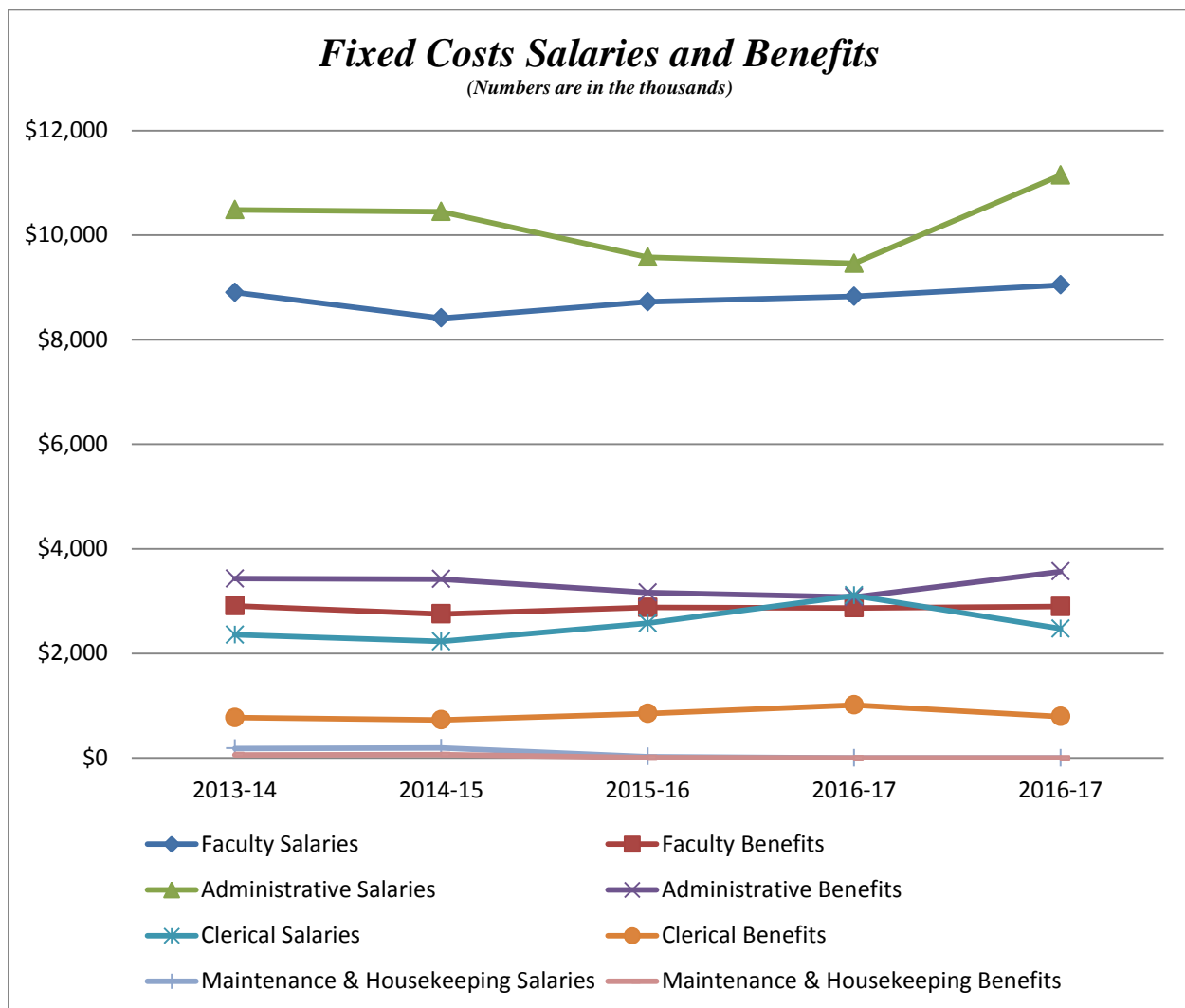

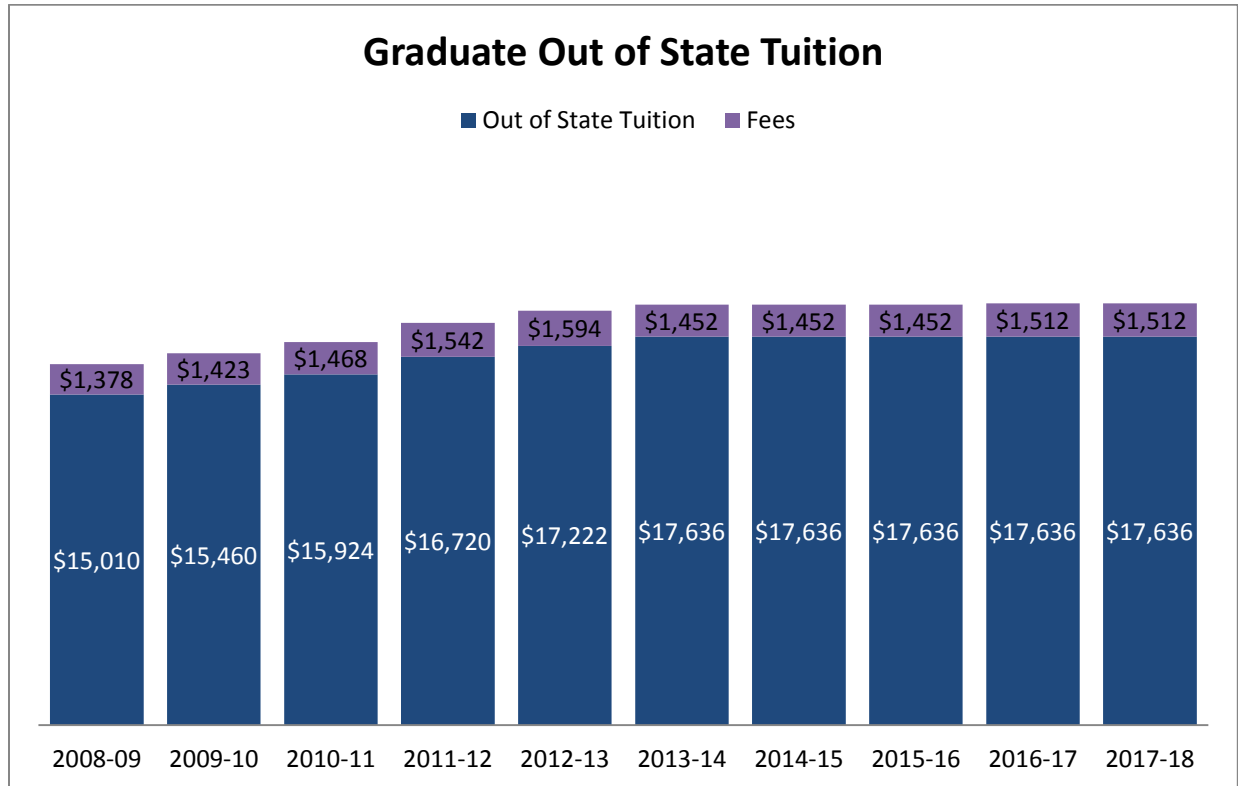
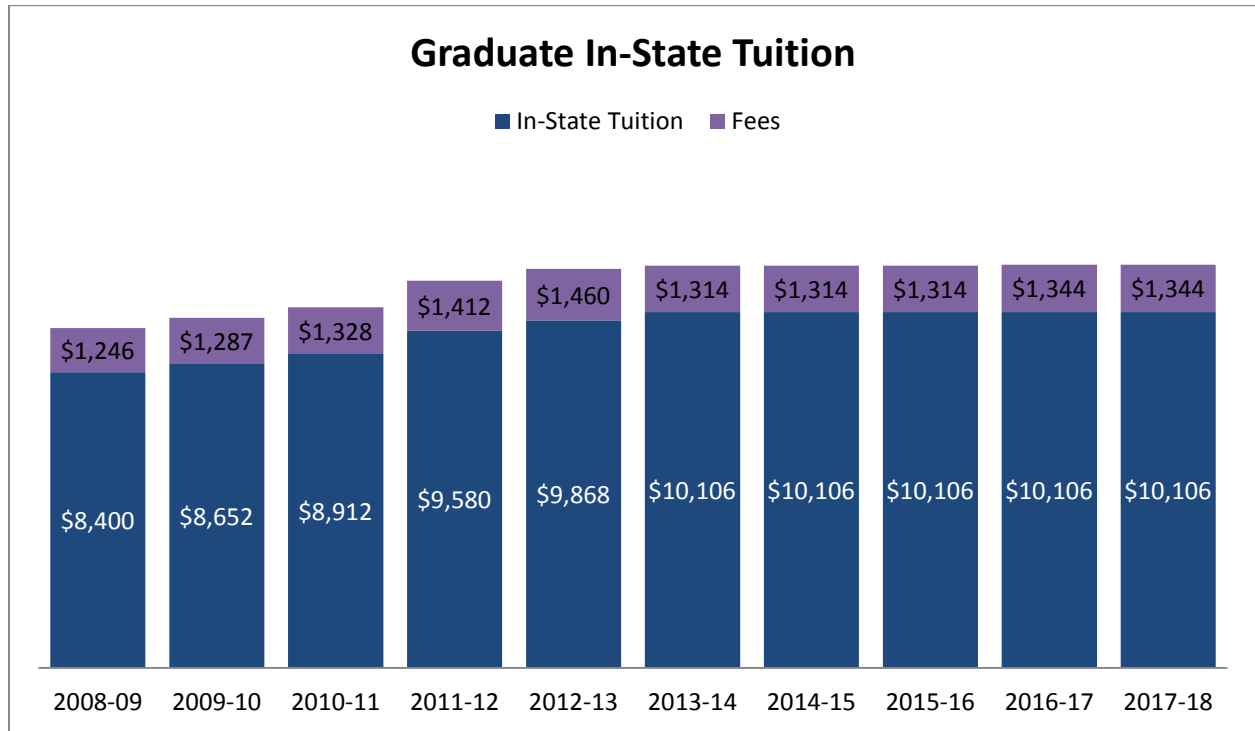


Fiscal Year Student Charges 2008 – 2017

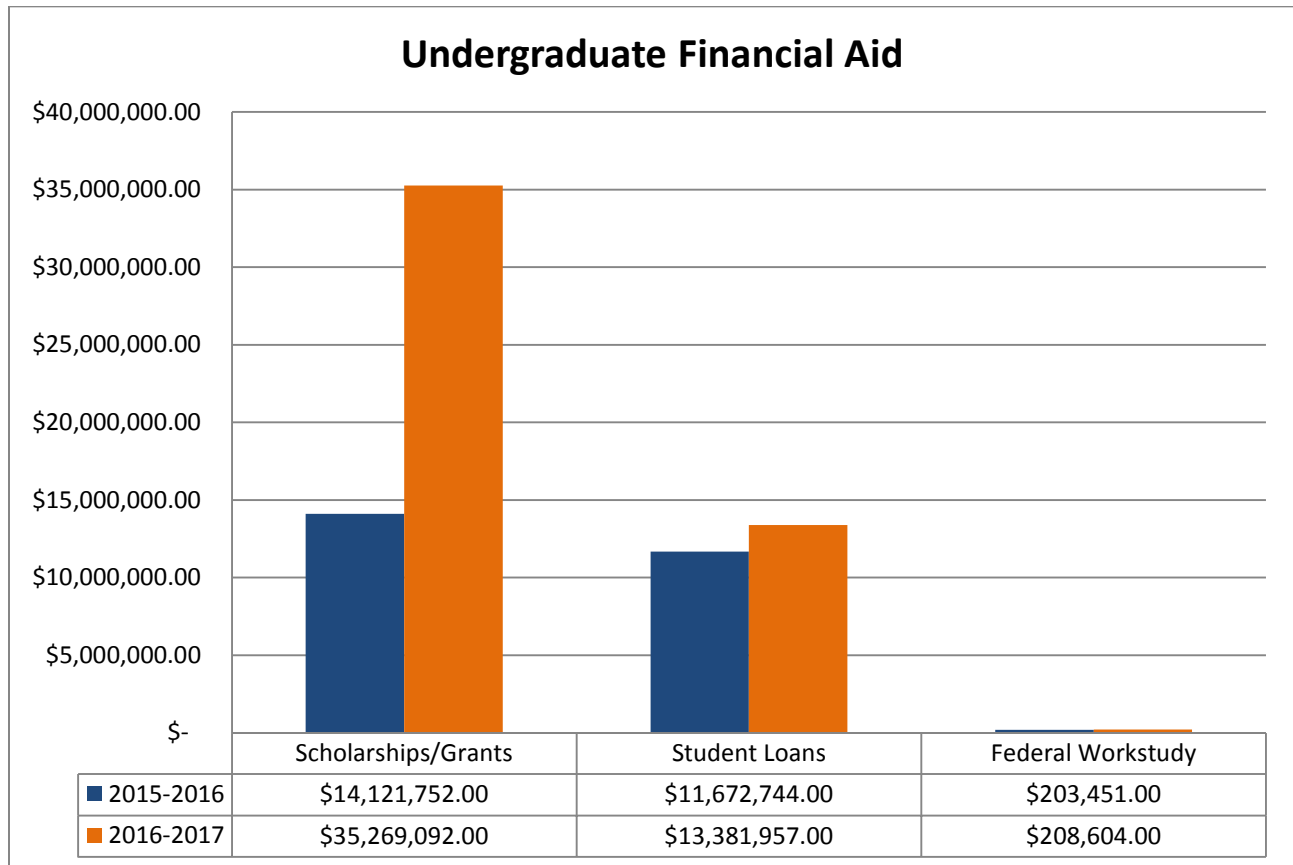
Undergraduate Charges

2015-2016 & 2016-2017 Comparison***



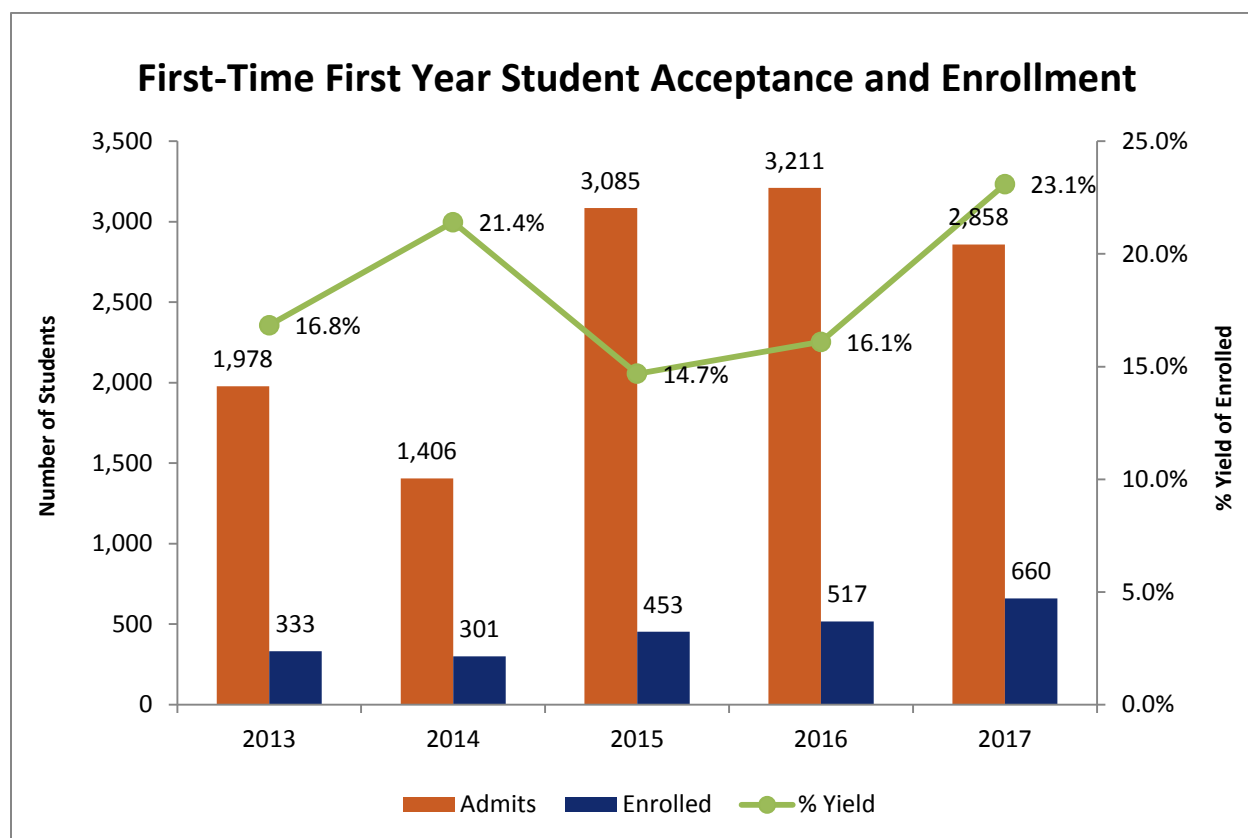

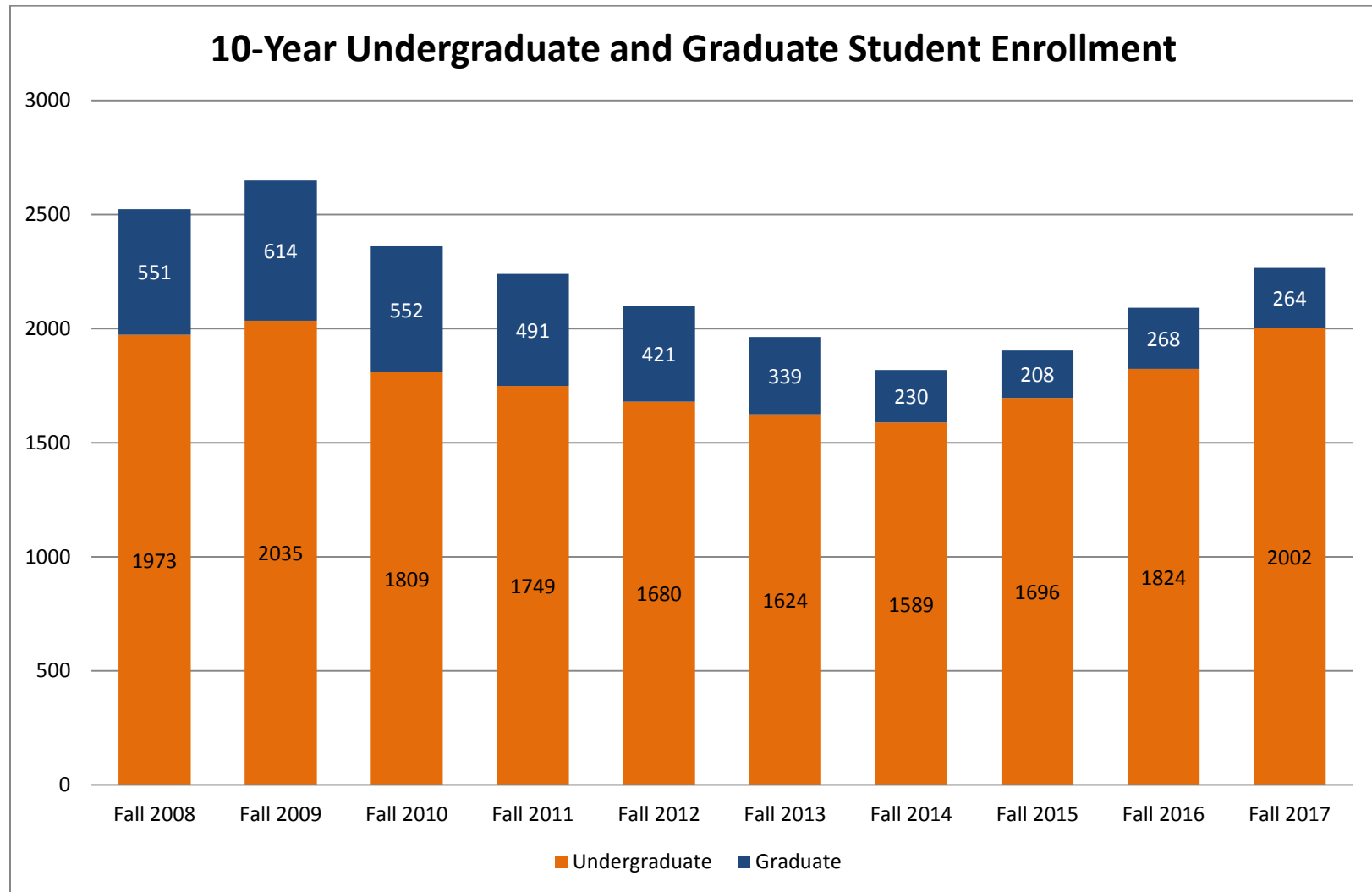

Fact Book Definitions

The purpose of this page is to define the terms used in the Fact Book as employed by Lincoln University to help the reader use the information in the tables and charts.

1. **Academic rank** - a job classification for faculty.
2. **Academic year** - the year beginning August and ending May.
3. **Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP)** - taxonomy for classification of instructional programs.
4. **First-time student**- a student who has no prior postsecondary experience attending any institution for the first time at the undergraduate level. This includes students enrolled in the fall term who attended college for the first time in the prior summer term, and students who entered with advanced standing (college credits or postsecondary formal award earned before graduation from high school).
5. **First-year student** - a student who has completed less than the equivalent of 1 full year of undergraduate work; that is, less than 30 semester hours (in a 120-hour degree program)
6. **Student levels - Undergraduate** - those students enrolled in programs leading to a BA or BS degree. **Graduate** - those students enrolled in the graduate programs, which leads to a master's degree.
7. **Student status - Full-time students** - those undergraduate students who are registered for 12 or more credit hours in a term and those graduate students who are registered 9 or more credit hours in a term. **Part-time students** - those undergraduate students who are registered for less than 12 credit hours in a term and those graduate students who are registered for less than 9 credit hours in a term.
8. **Black or African American** - a person having origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa
9. **White** - a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, or the Middle East, or North Africa.
10. **American Indian or Alaska Native** - a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community attachment.
11. **Asian** - a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian Subcontinent, including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.
12. **Hispanic/Latino** - a person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South America, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.
13. **Nonresident alien** - a person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. In no case should non-resident alien be included in any other category.
14. **Resident alien** – a person who is not a citizen of the United States but has been lawfully admitted for permanent residence. (He/she holds an alien registration receipt card (Green Card) - form I-551/155.) He/she is to be reported in the appropriate racial/ethnic category along with the United States citizens.
15. **FTE students** - the number for undergraduate students is calculated by the following formula: $FTE\ Students = Full\ time\ students\ headcount + (Part\ time\ students\ headcount * 0.403543)$. The number for graduate students is calculated by the following formula: $FTE\ Students = Full\ time\ students\ headcount + (Part\ time\ students\ headcount * 0.361702)$.
