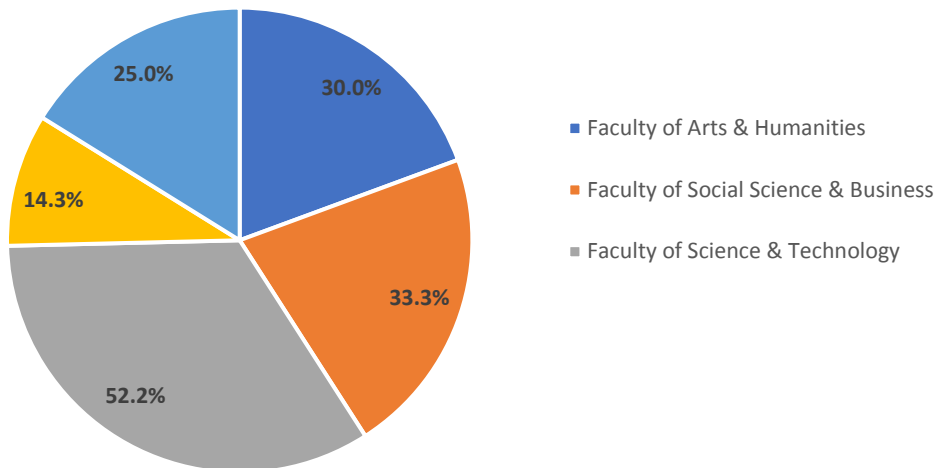
# By-Laws & Nominations

Percentage of faculty by discipline/division not currently serving in any committee



- A total of 108 faculty
- Quorum must be met
- Approval of the By-laws requires 2/3 votes from a Quorum of eligible faculty members, which must also constitute a majority of the voting-eligible faculty (108)
