Three courses coming from the Dept. of Languages & Literature, ENG315 Lit. Mag. Pub., ENG330 Fic. Workshop & ENG335 Adv. Poetry Workshop. ENG330 and ENG335 will become required courses for the English major Creative Writing track. ENG315 will be an elective for any student. All of these courses have ENG102 as the prerequisite. These courses have been reviewed and approved by the Curriculum Committee. The syllabi and aligned documents should be posted for faculty review for approval of syllabi at the next Faculty Meeting.

These courses will primarily affect English majors in the Creative Wring track, though ENG315 will provide any Lincoln student the options of receiving credit for working on Lincoln's literary magazine of the arts.

The Faculty Council has no critical issues with ENG330 or ENG335. *The FC recommends* that for the course ENG315, Lit. Mag. Pub., the Language and Literature Department should consult with Visual and Performing Arts and Business and Entrepreneurial Departments for the elements that address digital layout and fundraising for the publication.
