## Faculty Council Proposal Summary

### ***Executive Summary in one paragraph***

The Standing Committee on General Education is putting forth a proposal to change the wording for ILO 1 Effective Communication from:

#### **ILO 1: Effective Communication**

Effectively and clearly communicate through verbal, written, and visual means to increase knowledge and understanding or to promote change in a listener, reader, or observer respectively.

**Outcome:** Students will effectively communicate in verbal, written, and visual form.

To:

#### **ILO 1: Effective *Written, Verbal, and Visual* Communication**

Use effective written, verbal, or visual communication to increase knowledge and understanding of a given subject, stimulate an intellectual or emotional response, or promote change in a listener, reader, or observer.

**Outcome:** Students will effectively communicate in verbal, written, or visual form.

### ***Exact Wording of the Proposed Motion***

The Standing Committee on General Education proposes to update the wording for ILO 1: Effective Communication to:

#### **ILO 1: Effective *Written, Verbal, and Visual* Communication**

Use effective written, verbal, or visual communication to increase knowledge and understanding of a given subject, stimulate an intellectual or emotional response, or promote change in a listener, reader, or observer.

**Outcome:** Students will effectively communicate in verbal, written, or visual form.

### ***Who the proposal will affect and how***

The change brings the types of communication to the forefront by incorporating them in the abbreviated version of the ILO wording. No other major change in teaching, learning, or assessment is anticipated.

### ***Summary of Proposal's Critical Issues***

The proposed change accompanies the proposal to make all general education courses writing, critical reading, or quantitative reasoning intensive. The main purpose of the proposal is to make the explicit connection between ILO 1 (Currently Effective Communication) and writing.
