As of October 1, the 2019-2020 FAFSA opened for submission. A completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) starts a student's awarding process for the next academic year. Students will need to have FSA IDs and 2017 tax information to complete the application. The IRS Data Retrieval Tool is strongly encouraged to make income reporting easier and more accurate.
